

Life Group Study Guide #2 for April 2, 2017

Anchor Point
1 Corinthians 15:17-20

Jesus' resurrection is a sure anchor point in the midst of our doubts.

- Faith in Jesus means nothing if He didn't rise from the dead. (15:17-19)

- Faith in Jesus is perfectly secure if He did. (15:17-20)

Jesus was raised so be confident in your faith.

2. How did it go applying what you learned last week?
3. What did you hear in the sermon that was surprising, challenging, troubling, or useful? Explain.
4. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-20 aloud (in two different versions if possible).
 - a. What did you like about the passage? What questions do you have after reading it?

 - b. What does this passage tell you about God?

 - c. What does it tell you about humankind?
5. What difference does it make to you whether or not Jesus is risen?
6. How do you describe your faith in a risen Jesus whom you have never personally seen to those who do not believe? What, if anything, can you say to give them confidence that Jesus is real and He is risen?
7. What is God saying to you? What is one thing you can do in the next seven days to obey what God is telling you?
