

## Life Group Study Guide #3 for April 9, 2017

### ***No More Shame*** Hebrews 10:12-14

**Christ is risen from the dead, so be confident of righteousness in the face of shame.**

- Christ's death and resurrection makes us righteous. (Hebrews 10:12-14)
  - Jesus, our High Priest, offered Himself as the full and final sacrifice for our sins. (Hebrews 10:12a)
  - Jesus is now seated at the right hand of God where He is waiting until all evil is overthrown. (Hebrews 10:12b-13)
  - Jesus can sit and wait because His one offering of Himself is sufficient to make us always perfectly acceptable to God for we are made holy. (Hebrews 10:14)
- Be confident of righteousness because of the resurrection. (Hebrews 10:19-20; Romans 4:25)

A dead Christ provides payment for sin and death.  
A living Christ imparts righteousness and life.

4. Read Hebrews 10:11-25 aloud (in two different versions if possible).

  - c. What does it tell you about humankind?
5. What is something you've felt shame for in your life? How might the resurrection of Jesus make a difference in that for you?
6. Which one of the "let us" statements of Hebrews 10:22-25 is most difficult for you?
7. What is God saying to you? What is one thing you can do in the next seven days to obey what God is telling you?
